Refunds:

Course costs are refundable **up to one week before the course start date** except for a \$250.00 administration fee.

The full cost of the course is non-refundable a week before the course start date.

A Doctor's certificate is required if sick days arise and another date will be booked to continue the training.

After the Acrylic & Gel Polish Foundation course:

The trainee must then put in at least 3 hours per week practice and can charge trainee prices.

Before and after photographs of clients done by the student of sculptured and tipped acrylic enhancements, rebalance/backfill nails, and gel polish manicures/pedicures, need to be sent to the educator during the time before their exam.

A **Refining & Perfecting** class, 12.30-5pm, will be held 6 weeks after the initial training to help the student master these newly learn skills at a cost of \$250.00 and payment is required upon booking.

A **practical and theory exam** will be offered three months later (but can be extended if the student needs more time to perfect her nails, but this needs to be done within the 12 months). The exam morning or afternoon is \$250.00 and payment is required upon booking of the exam.

The Trainee Nail Technician Certificate will expire 12 months after the student's initial training course if they have not sat and passed their exam.

QUALIFICATION

INM Nail Technician Certificate – Internationally Recognised

Caught Red Handed Nail Technician Certificate – National Standards

These Nail Technician Certificates will be awarded to students who have attended the novice course, completed at least 10 new sets of acrylic enhancements and 10 rebalances/backfills, and 15 gel polish manicures/pedicures, including removals, and passed their practical and theory exams over at least a three-month period and within the twelve-month period.

They will have demonstrated to a high standard the skills and knowledge to perform a range of nail services at a professional level within the commercial environment.

Those skills are:

Demonstrate knowledge of the structure and functions of a nail, and nail anatomy and physiology relevant to nail services.

Demonstrate knowledge of conditions of the nail and surrounding skin.

Demonstrate knowledge of micro-organisms that may be present in a salon environment.

Demonstrate knowledge of tools, equipment, products; and safe operating procedures used in nail services.

Demonstrate safe and professional practice in the salon environment.

Undertake an in-depth consultation and give advice, recommend nail products and services to meet client needs in a nail salon.

Perform nail augmentation application and maintenance in Acrylic.

Perform safe removal of all nail enhancements.

Perform gel polish nail applications for hands and feet.

Perform safe removal of gel polish nail applications.

Create appointments and maintain appointments systems and records in the salon environment.

Select and recommend products for at-home nail care plus the ability to on sell other services offered in a nail salon.
